## **PROGRAM CHANGES** EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1, 2024

## ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS FOR COLLEGE & MONTESSORI PROGRAM CREDENTIAL

- The Academic Scholarships program will not accept new Master's Degree applicants after October 1, 2024
- Eligibility changes effective October 1, 2024: Early childhood educators must remain employed with an eligible employer for 6 months and work a minimum of 30 hours per week (or a minimum of 15 hours per week for those working in before/after school programs licensed by DECAL)
- The Academic Scholarships POWER-ED wage supplement program will end at the conclusion of the Fall 2024 semester

## CDA SCHOLARSHIPS

- CDA Training Scholarships will cover up to \$500 of the cost of CDA Training after October 1, 2024
- Eligibility changes effective October 1, 2024: Early childhood educators must remain employed with an eligible employer for 6 months and work a minimum of 30 hours per week (or a minimum of 15 hours per week for those working in before/after school programs licensed by DECAL)

## INCENTIVES

- Eligibility will remain the same in 2024, but will change effective in 2025: Early childhood educators must work a minimum of 30 hours per week (or a minimum of 15 hours per week for those working in before/after school programs licensed by DECAL)
- Effective in 2025, the Incentives award will be \$1,000 annually for all approved applicants
